ORRCA's Annual Whale Census Day Sunday, 29 June, 8am-4pm

Cape St George Lighthouse, Booderee National Park



Join us and the ORRCA team to count the whales as they migrate north. Also learn about the cultural significance of the area from one of Booderee's traditional owners with your hosts from Galamban Extraordinary Aboriginal experiences.



Humpback and Southern Right whales begin their northerly migration in early April and continue until mid to late August, heading to their breeding grounds in the warmer tropical waters off Queensland.



Booderee National Park is one of the best places on the South Coast to view the whale migration. Late June and early July is the peak time to view these majestic creatures.
