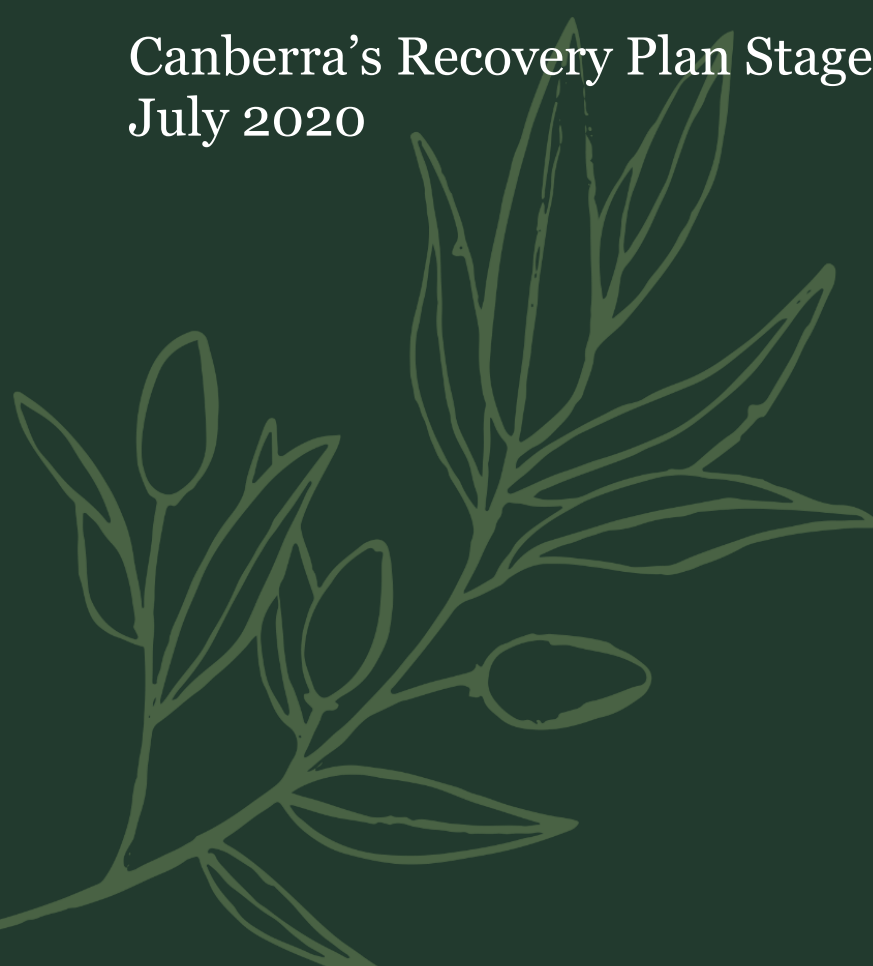

COVID-19 Information for School Visits

Education COVID-19 Safety Measures

With the easing of COVID-19 restrictions, our education team has implemented several procedures to ensure the continued safety of students, teachers and staff during excursions to the Australian National Botanic Gardens (ANBG). While still encouraging an immersive outdoor experience, all our facilitated education programs adhere to [ACT Government regulations and requirements](#) and the latest advice from the [ACT Education Directorate](#). School groups must ensure they comply with all safety measures in place.

For all education programs the following safety measures are in place.

Maximum Group Size

The maximum school group size is restricted to 100 attendees including students, teachers and assistants.

Physical Distancing

Facilitated education programs that use an indoor space are limited to one person per 4 square metres. Students are not expected to socially distance from each other, however all educators should maintain a distance of 1.5 metres between themselves.

ANBG Staff are trained in social distancing and will maintaining a distance of 1.5 metres between themselves and all attendees. To enable this, portable microphones are in use to ensure students can hear presenters and to reduce airborne infection risk.

Cleaning & Sanitation

ANBG Staff are trained in appropriate cleaning and disinfection methods. All equipment is disinfected prior to use and control measures are in place to ensure there is no shared equipment use. All indoor spaces used for education program purposes will be cleaned and sanitised in preparation for use following the [WorkSafe ACT Cleaning Checklist](#).

Hygiene

All education programs have hygiene and hand sanitising stations provided. ANBG Staff are trained to ensure appropriate hand and respiratory hygiene. The ANBG has departmental guidelines in place to ensure staff stay home if they are feeling unwell or if they have been in close contact with a person who has or is currently being tested for COVID-19.

During July and August, the Gardens will be offering a limited number of programs. This ensures that each education program has specific COVID-19 safety measures in place and staff training conducted.
