

PLANNING YOUR VISIT

VISITOR INFORMATION CENTRE

On arrival, make the Visitor Information Centre your first stop at the Gardens. Pick up a visitor map and get ideas for your visit.

Open from 9:30 am to 4:30 pm seven days a week.

FREE GUIDED WALKS

Tours depart the Visitor Information Centre at 11.00 am and 2.00 pm daily.

FLORA EXPLORER ELECTRIC BUS TOURS

Enjoy a 45-minute highlight tour of the Gardens. Tours run on selected days. Cost applies; tickets from the Botanical Bookshop.

WALKING TRACKS

The wheelchair-accessible 1.4 km Main Path loops through the Gardens. Radiating out from the Main Path are sealed and unsealed walking trails for visitors to experience all the Gardens has to offer.

TROPICAL GLASSHOUSE

Displays the Gardens' collection of tropical and sub-tropical plants. The native orchids are a highlight in spring.

BOTANICAL BOOKSHOP

Features a large selection of botanical books, unique Australian gifts and souvenirs.

Stop in for breakfast, lunch, morning or afternoon tea and enjoy a relaxing outdoor dining experience.

HOW TO GET HERE

PARKING: Ample parking available, including disability spaces. Parking fees apply.

RIDE: An easy 5 minute bicycle ride from the city. Bikes not permitted beyond the car park.

Mon – Fri: ACTION bus route No. 3 to ANU (10 mins walk to the Gardens).

Weekends: ACTION bus route No. 981 direct to the Gardens' bus stop.

ACT School Holidays: Mon – Fri ACTION bus route No. 81 direct to the Gardens' bus stop.

Experience the iconic plants, rich red sand, rocks and landscapes of Central Australia.




SYDNEY REGION FLORA
