



Public Talk 'Abating the threat from feral animals: policy to practical action'

To coincide with the launch of 'Bilby's Ring' a new trilogy of books by Australian author Kaye Kessing, Julie Quinn will be giving a talk about her work on feral animal policy at the Department of Environment. In Australia, feral animals have a huge impact on native species, and are a major cause of decline in many of our threatened species. Control of feral animals can be complex and challenging. Julie will discuss how science is incorporated into feral animal control policies and programs, and the importance of monitoring and recording changes.
