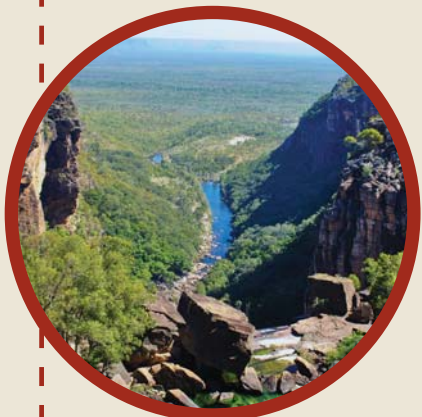
## Explore our ancient galleries
