CLASS APPROVAL – EXCAVATIONS, DREDGING, ERECTION OF STRUCTURES, WORKS AND MAINTENANCE, AND ASSOCIATED ACTIVITIES

Approved Actions	Carrying on an excavation including dredging, the erection of a structure

Approved Actions within Approved Zones	Excavations other than dredging, erection of Structures, carrying out
	works and maintenance, and associated activities - in all zones.
	Dredging - in Special Purpose Zones (Trawl), Special Purpose
	Zones, Special Purpose Zones (Mining Exclusion) and Multiple Use
	Zones only.
Conditions of Approval	The Approved Actions must be conducted in accordance with:
	(a) an approval issued under Part 9 of the EPBC Act;
	(b) the EPBC Act;
	(c) the EPBC Regulations;
	(d) the Network Management Plan;
	(e) any prohibitions, restrictions or determinations made under the
	EPBC Regulations by the Director of National Parks; and
	(f) all other applicable Commonwealth and state laws (to the exten
	that those laws are capable of operating concurrently with the
	laws and instruments described in paragraphs (a) to (e)).
	If requested by the Director of National Parks, an Approved Person
	must notify the Director prior to conducting Approved Actions within
	Approved Zones.
	Note: The timeframe for prior notice will be agreed to by the Directo
	of National Parks and the Approved Person.
	3. If requested by the Director of National Parks, an Approved Person
	must provide the Director with information relating to the
	performance of the Approved Actions (or gathered during the
	performance of the Approved Actions), which is relevant to the
	management of the Approved Zones.
	Note: The information required, and timeframe within which it is
	required, will be agreed to by the Director of National Parks and the
	Approved Person.

- 4. A copy (hard or electronic) of this class approval and the approval under Part 9 of the EPBC Act must be kept on board any vessel used in the conduct of the Approved Actions and must be produced for inspection on request by an Authorised Officer.
- A navigational chart showing the boundaries of the Approved Zones in which the Approved Actions are being conducted, must be kept or be otherwise accessible on board the vessel.

Approved Persons in the South-west Marine Parks Network need to be aware of the following requirements:

- 1. Transiting is allowed in all zones (Section 4.2.2.1 of the South-west Marine Parks Network Management Plan).
- 2. Anchoring is allowed anywhere in Special Purpose Zones (Trawl), Special Purpose Zones, Special Purpose Zones (Mining Exclusion) and Multiple Use Zones. Anchoring is allowed in Habitat Protection Zones and National Park Zones in anchoring areas that have been determined by the Director of National Parks (Section 4.2.2.2 of the South-west Marine Parks Network Management Plan) or areas where the Approved Actions are being undertaken.

The Director of National Parks may vary, suspend or cancel this class approval at any time, in accordance with Section 4.4.2 of the Network Management Plan.

Contravention of this class approval may result in the imposition of civil or criminal penalties and/or the removal of a person or persons from this approval.

This class approval will come into effect on 1 July 2018 and remain in effect for the term of the South-west Marine Parks Network Management Plan 2018, unless it is suspended or cancelled sooner by the Director of National Parks.

Interpretation

In this class approval:

- 1. Approved Actions means the actions described as Approved Actions in this class approval.
- Approved Person means a person in the class of persons described as Approved Persons in this
 approval and includes the employees, servants, agents and contractors of an Approved Person; but
 does not include a person removed from the class of Approved Persons by a variation to this class
 approval.
- 3. **Approved Zones** means a Zone in which the Approved Actions are authorised by this class approval to be carried out.
- 4. Authorised Officer means a warden or an inspector under the EPBC Act.
- 5. **Director of National Parks** means Director of National Parks continuing under section 514A of the EPBC Act and includes any agency that succeeds to the functions of the Director of National Parks.
- 6. **Dredging activity** means an excavation activity carried out to gather bottom sediments for the purpose of moving them to a different location. This excludes disposal of dredge material.
- 7. **EPBC Act** means the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (Cth) and includes any Act that amends or replaces the EPBC Act.
- 8. **EPBC Regulations** mean the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Regulations* 2000 (Cth) and includes any Regulations that amend or replace the EPBC Regulations.
- South-west Marine Parks Network means collectively the Abrolhos, Bremer, Eastern Recherche, Geographe, Great Australian Bight, Jurien, Murat, Perth Canyon, South-west Corner, Southern Kangaroo Island, Twilight, Two Rocks, Western Eyre and Western Kangaroo Island Marine Parks established and described in the Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation (Commonwealth Marine Reserves) Proclamation 2013.
- South-west Marine Parks Network Management Plan or Network Management Plan means the South-west Marine Parks Network Management Plan 2018 made under section 370 of the EPBC Act.
- 11. **Structures** may include, but are not limited to, moorings, submarine cables, platforms (including any man made structure at sea, whether floating or fixed to the seabed, but does not include a vessel), jetties and other infrastructure. For the purposes of this class approval, this definition excludes:
 - (a) the erection, maintenance and decommissioning of structures associated with mining operations
 - (b) Fish Aggregating Devices, and
 - (c) artificial reefs.
- 12. Transit or Transiting means the continuous and expeditious passage through an area. However, passage includes stopping and anchoring, but only in so far as rendered necessary by force majeure or distress or for the purpose of rendering assistance to persons, ships or aircraft in danger or distress.
- 13. Vessel means a ship, boat, tender, raft or pontoon or any other thing capable of carrying persons or goods through or on water.
- 14. **Zone** means a management zone established by, and described under, Section 3.1 of the South-west Marine Parks Network Management Plan.
